



What can I do if I have concerns about development in my community?

If you are concerned about a development in your community there are several avenues through which you can have your concerns noted throughout the process. When providing feedback, it would be useful to be as specific as possible as to what your concerns are (ex. height, parking, traffic, etc.) and what their impact will be on the community.

1. **Marda Loop Communities Association:** Your community association comments on Land Use Amendments and Development Permits to The City. These comments will reflect feedback from the community and concerns raised. You can submit a letter to the MLCA Planning & Development Committee via email at: development@mardaloop.com.
2. **City Council:** Councillors vote on Land Use Amendments and provide comments on Development Permits. Get in touch with your ward Councillor:

3. **The City of Calgary:** Once the Land Use Amendment and Development Permit applications have been filed, you can provide comments to The City. Current applications can be found via this interactive map: <https://developmentmap.calgary.ca/#map> which provides information on the applications as well as contact information for the File Manager.
4. **The Developer:** Some developers do community engagement, and the MLCA encourages this. Take advantage of the opportunity to work with them to address your concerns.
5. **Public Hearings:** Land Use Amendment applications go before City Council for a vote. You can attend and present at these public hearings. If you are not able to attend the hearing, but wish to submit a letter you can do so via the City Clerk. 6. **Appeals:** If a Development Permit is approved, you can appeal it through the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board. More information on this process can be found here: <http://calgarysdab.ca/>.
