

MLCA Tennis/Pickleball Playing Rules

The MLCA Courts are a privilege to use. In order to maintain a positive environment, the MLCA requires all tennis/pickleball members and their guests to abide by appropriate conduct while utilizing the courts, sharing the courts appropriately, and being considerate of other players and groups:

- Ensure you are an active MLCA Member. Only MLCA Members are able to play on the courts. MLCA Members are able to bring in one guest.
- Tennis members should not provide access to the courts for those without a door code (or fob).
- Currently we operate with a First-Come, First-Serve policy, but we are looking into a Booking System in the future.
- There are a few times reserved for our Seniors Pickleball group and programs. Please visit our website (Mardaloop.com) for a full schedule.
- If someone arrives at the court and are waiting to play, please limit yourself to 30 minutes of playing time to allow for their turn.
- Hogging the courts will not be tolerated and could result in loss of Membership.
- Treat all players and spectators with respect and courtesy at all times. Rude behaviour will not be tolerated and could result in loss of Membership.
- Offensive or abusive language is not tolerated.
- Respect all property, surfaces, nets and fencing
- Members are responsible for ensuring guests are following the rules.
